Pastoral Council Nominee Characteristics

Nominees should have the following characteristics:

1. must have the ability to collaborate, *they lead with patience,*
2. a deep love for the parish and its mission, *they lead with joy,*
3. have a willingness to grow in holiness, *they lead with faith,*
4. a desire to serve, *they lead with humility,*
5. has a broad vision, *they lead with courage,*
6. is a continuous learner, *they lead with respect,*
7. has a sense of stewardship, *they lead with wisdom.*

Pastoral Council Eligibility Requirements:

Nominees must meet the following requirements:

1. be baptized and a practicing Catholic,
2. be an active member of our parish,
3. be at least 18 years old,
4. not be an employee of the parish.

Your nomination is your voice and vote. The Pastoral Council will add 3 new members from our pool of nominees using the Discernment Process. This process involves personal reflection, prayer and group dialogue to discern the will of the Holy Spirit.
